"Every day people in our community and state go hungry, and because of the ongoing pandemic, more people are experiencing food insecurity and relying on community-based services to feed themselves and their families," said **Rep. Turco**, who has been selected as a co-captain of the Newington Human Services team. "These are certainly challenging times, and our region's food banks and pantries are struggling to keep up with unprecedented demand. The Walk Against Hunger is a great way to get involved and directly help those in need."

The 37<sup>th</sup> Annual Foodshare Walk Against Hunger raises awareness of and resources to fight food insecurity in Hartford and Tolland counties. Funds raised will not only help Foodshare serve the growing number of people struggling with hunger, but its partner programs like the Newington Human Services Department Food Bank. This year the event will be held virtually. Participants will walk 1.5 miles anywhere they choose, even in their home, any day during the week of September 13-19, 2020.
