Summary

At approximately 6:30 a.m. on May 2, Eversource was notified of a tanker truck fire on I-95 South below the Fairfield Ave. Bridge. Company crews are on site, and we are working closely with emergency responders. The fire is extinguished, and the CT Department of Transportation officials and emergency responders are on the scene. An Eversource natural gas main line is connected to the underside of the bridge. Eversource crews are in the process of shutting off the flow of natural gas through the mainline under the bridge.

What is the emergency situation?	 A tanker truck transporting gasoline on I-95 South caught fire and stopped beneath the Fairfield Ave. Bridge. State highway officials and emergency responders are onsite to determine the impact on the bridge. An Eversource natural gas mainline is attached to the underside of the bridge. For safety, Eversource is in the process of shutting off the flow of natural gas through the mainline on the bridge. Eversource crews are onsite and working with the Connecticut Department of Transportation, DEEP and local emergency responders to address any safety concerns related to the mainline. I-95 in both directions in the area of Exit 15 in Norwalk is closed, as is the Fairfield Ave. bridge.
